# RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: ADULT FAITH FORMATION AND SPIRITUALITY

## Evening Adult Faith Formation

**MONDAY, June 11th at 6:15pm,

Christians and many non-Christians have long accepted Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John—the four Gospels of the New Testament—as the only reliable accounts of the life and teaching of Jesus of Nazareth. Recent media stories and certain best-selling books have alerted the public to alternative writings about Jesus, leading many people—including many believers—to wonder why we should consider only the four New Testament Gospels as “gospel truth.”

The alternative writings about Jesus bear the names of such prominent early Christians as Peter, Thomas, Mary Magdalene, Judas, James, and Andrew. Some of these writings purport to contain “secret” teachings of Jesus, to recount his childhood, or to fill in other gaps in this story. Some contradict the New Testament. What should informed believers and nonbelievers make of them? Were they written by disciples of Jesus as they claim? How do they compare with the New Testament Gospels? Are these works “lost gospels” or “false gospels”? In this thought-provoking DVD, top scholars of early Christian writings answer these and other crucial questions. They discuss the relationship between these works and the New Testament. The experts also explore Gnostic writings such as the “Gospel of Thomas” and the “Gospel of Judas,” and they reveal startling facts about the groups who composed them. Anyone who is interested in the truth about Jesus and the early Church must see this movie: *Lost Gospels or False Gospels?*

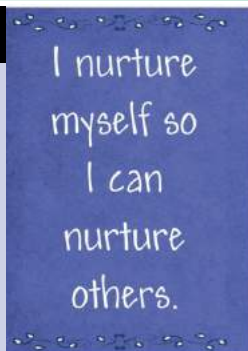

## On the Caregiving Journey...

For the past three weeks, we have been exploring some ideas of how 24/7 caregivers can work self-care time into their busy caregiving schedules. Several options have been presented including hiring professional caregivers, asking family and friends to visit the care receiver while the caregiver takes a break, and taking the loved one to an adult day care center.



If these three options are not feasible, the caregiver can consider incorporating self-care time and activities into his/her caregiving schedule. This may seem impossible at first glance, but can be done by using the care receiver's downtime as self-care time. Generally, a care receiver's downtime is when she/he is sleeping or napping. If the care receiver is a late riser or goes to bed early, the caregiver can get up earlier and/or stay up later to capture some quiet "me" time. If the care receiver likes to nap during the day, the caregiver can also take advantage of those breaks. During the care receiver's downtime, the caregiver can engage in any fulfilling and renewing activity such as listening to music, meditating, reading, praying, working puzzles, arts and crafts, etc. that will not disturb the care receiver. While the caregiver is still technically engaged in caregiving, it is at a different level of involvement that provides the caregiver with an opportunity to slow down, take a few deep breaths, and re-energize.

All caregivers at different levels of caregiving are welcome at our caregiver support group meetings each month. During our meetings caregivers share your stories and knowledge, learn from others' experiences and leave feeling affirmed for all that they are doing to assist and serve their loved ones. Our next meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday, June 13, at 2:30 p.m. in classrooms 1-2 at Mountain Vista Medical Center** (southeast corner of Crismon and Southern Avenue in Mesa).
